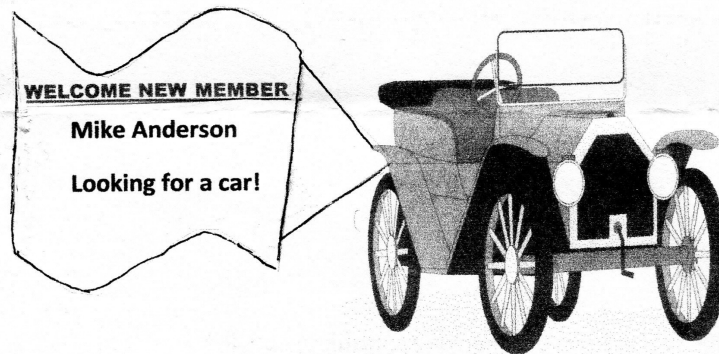

## Tour report

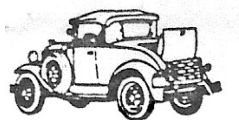
